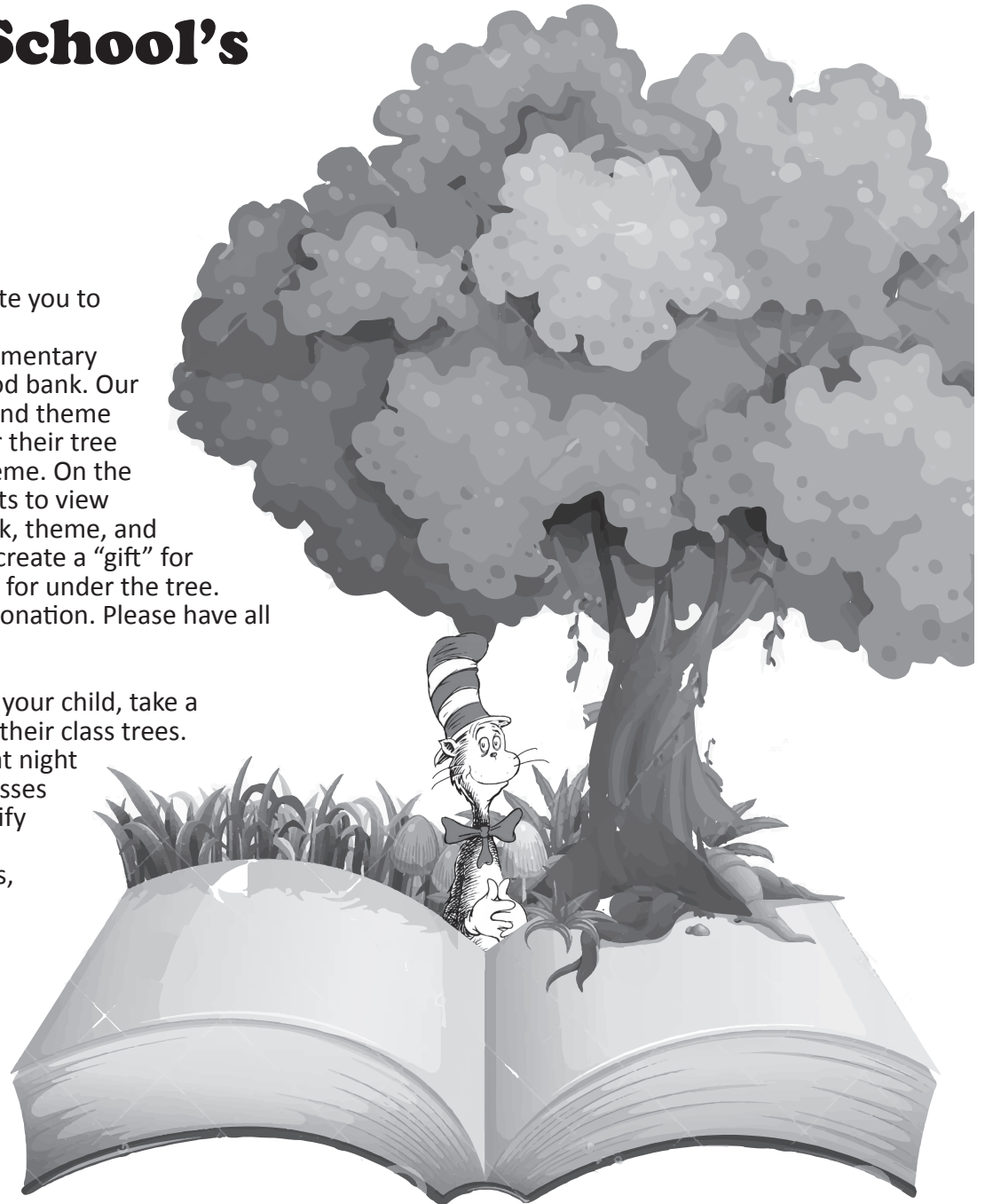
Moraine Elementary School's Storybook Forest!

As part of our Moraine Elementary Family, we would like to invite you to our annual "Storybook Forest", from 6:00pm-8:00pm on **Friday December 9th**. This event was created to bring the Moraine Elementary School community together, along with supporting our local food bank. Our children have worked with a buddy class to choose their book and theme they will use to decorate a tree. They will create decorations for their tree by choosing the most important things about their book/ or theme. On the evening of December 9th, students and staff will welcome guests to view the beautiful trees and share the connections between the book, theme, and tree. In addition each child's class will also collect donations to create a "gift" for underneath their tree! If you would like, send in a donation/gift for under the tree. Families are welcome to pool their resources to make a larger donation. Please have all donations in to the school by Monday December 5th.

When you come to Storybook Forest, bring a book to read with your child, take a walk through our enchanting forest, and talk to students about their class trees. You can also purchase 50/50 tickets, or present raffle tickets that night for a chance to win the wonderful gifts that our families and classes created. On December 12th, the offices will pull names and notify the gift winners. 4th grade- Boxed Side Dishes (stuffing, rice, pasta, ...)

5th Grade- Breakfast items (cereal, oatmeal, breakfast bars, ...)
